Reduced Field Size Game Focus:

By playing soccer on a reduced size field with fewer players, a child is able to discover soccer on his/her own terms. The players are being introduced to additional soccer concepts. FIFA Rules are starting to be more rigidly enforced to prepare the player for the Intermediate and Senior Divisions. We continue to promote good sportsmanship and teamwork.

We want the players to learn and have fun.

No scores or standings are kept.

1. Games will be played at the Main Campus. The field size is reduced to allow players more touches on the ball.
 2. **The coaches of the first games scheduled for that day will check the nets on the goals.**
 3. There will be referees assigned to each game. For the most part these will be youth referees so refrain from yelling.
 4. Coaches and players should be located on the opposite side from the parents. Parents should refrain from coming to the player bench during the game.
 5. A maximum of 3 parents/coaches should be on the player side at any one time. No siblings of players should be on the benches of the playing teams.
 6. Coaches will agree, before the start of the games, as to the team size. 7V7 is the ideal team size for each field.
- ****IMPORTANT******
7. **Parents and spectators must sit on the opposite side of the players. To help the coaches keep order, non-coaching parents and non-playing children should NOT sit with the team. This will help the coaches keep straight who is in and out of the game. PLEASE EXPLAIN THIS TO ALL OF YOUR TEAM'S PARENTS AND SPECTATORS BEFORE, AND AT, THE FIRST GAME.**

Game Rules

Definitions:

- The goal-line(s) is (are) those that define the length of the field.
 - The touch-line(s) is (are) those that define the width of the field.
 - The center-line is the line in the center of the field.
 - The center-circle is the circle intersected by the center-line
 - A goal is scored when the whole of the ball crosses the goal-line, between the goal posts and under the crossbar.
 - A goal-kick is when the attacking team kicks the ball past the goal-line at their offensive end. The ball shall be spotted in the goal-area and kicked in by the defensive team.
 - A corner-kick is when the defending team kicks the ball past the goal-line near the goal they are defending. The ball will be placed at the corner of the goal and touch-lines where the ball was kicked out. The attacking team will take the kick.
 - All players should move back approximately 10 yards away from the kicker on a corner-kick or out of the penalty-area on a goal-kick.
-
- All fouls that occur in the penalty-area will result in a penalty kick.
 - FIFA rules will apply to all fouls committed by a player. The severity and nature of the foul will determine the awarding of an indirect or direct kick.
 - The referee will attempt to explain infractions to the offending player.
 - Referees will watch the pushing and tripping, early in the game, stop play and talk to each team about it.
 - No second chances on throw-ins.
 - No slide tackling is allowed.
 - **Parents and spectators should control their emotions during the game or they will be asked to leave the field area.**

- **Game Play:**
- Each team consists of generally 6 players plus a goalie.
- Teams shall play with an equal number of players.
- Games shall consist of four (4), eight (12) minute quarters.
- Games are considered complete after two quarters have been played.
- Games shall **NOT** be rescheduled by the coaches. Rescheduling of games shall be approved by the Director of Fields & Scheduling.
- Players are not required to stay on the same field for the entire game, but must stay on the field that they started the quarter on.
- Substitutions are made at the end of the quarter or at an injury only. **NO** free substitutions unless a team has more than 2 players on the bench. A substitute will be made half way through the first quarter only. This will result in two players playing 2.5 quarters. There will be a 2-minute rest period between quarters and a 5-minute rest at the half.
- There will be **GOALIES**. EACH PLAYER MUST PLAY AT LEAST ONE QUARTER OF OFFENSE AND A TOTAL OF THREE QUARTERS. MIDFIELD IS CONSIDERED AN OFFENSIVE POSITION.
- **The concept of "Offside" penalties is being introduced into this division. The call of offsides is determined by the judgment of the referee at the time the ball was kicked.**
- All balls that cross the touchline completely will result in a throw-in.

WHEN THE BALL GOES ACROSS THE GOAL LINE &

- it was last touched by the defensive team; the offensive team will take the kick from the corner closest to the goal they are shooting at.

- it was last kicked by the offensive team the defensive team will place it ANYWHERE in the goal box. All players from the non-kicking team should be outside the big box (it is 12 feet out from the goal. They must kick it out of the big box before it can be touched by another player.

- Home team will take the kickoff during the first half and the other team during the second half. Change direction of team play at the half only.

Remember the goal of these games is fun and fundamentals.
